During this meeting we talked about the different options Psychology students have professionally




General Meeting 2: Graduate Degrees in Psychology

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss about the process of applying to Grad school as a Psychology student and the types of degrees available


General Meeting 3: The Psychology of Horror
